

Please pass this email and attachment to the CDD BOS as my response to the action to review the community letter from our last meeting.

Tom took the admirable initiative to draft 5 topics to share with the community and he asked for the board's feedback. Whatever modifications we make would not be possible if Tom had not made the initial effort. Thank you, Tom.

I have provided my updated draft for consideration in the attached. A general explanation of the changes by the topic.

I changed the mission of the letter from a 'reporting system' communication to an 'informative' communication including our vendor activities.

The Nuisance alligator topic: I changed the link to the IFAS for Nuisance Alligators which covers the topic more specifically than the general information link. I added the phone number to report a Nuisance Alligator and dropped the 'be aware' section which is covered more thoroughly in the new IFAS link.

Stressed or dead fish topic: A sentence was added requesting to report findings to the CDD District Manager.

Floating debris topic: Our aquatic vendor schedule was added and then asked if there are findings between vendor visits to report them to the CDD District Manager.

Erosion of pond banks topic: The District Engineer study which will thoroughly assess all pond banks was added.

Wetland areas topic: The Del Webb wetland geography was added but the request to report problems was deleted since we do not give residents a definition of wetland problems to report.

Feedback Instructions topic: Minor clarifications added.

Dear Del Webb Bexley Community Members,

Your CDD would like to inform you about topics involving DWB community ponds and wetland areas. Feedback instructions and contact information are provided below.

- 1. Nuisance alligators: Information about the Statewide Nuisance Alligator Program in Florida can be found at the following website:
- https://myfwc.com/wildlifehabitats/wildlife/alligator/snap/
 If you have a nuisance alligator you can call 1-866-FWC-Gator (1-866-392-4286). The owner of the property needs to approve FWC to enter the property. You will be given a reference number that needs to be provided to the owner of the property where the alligator was observed. In most cases the alligator would be near one of the ponds which are owned by the CDD. When you provide the reference number to the CDD (contact information below), the CDD would call the same number with the reference number and a trapper would be dispatched to remove the alligator.
- 2. Dead fish: The CDD would like to know if you observe a fish kill. If so, please contact the CDD District Manager and report your findings. Factors such as water temperature, disease or chemical imbalance can affect pond ecosystems, to the degree that fish begin to die. Rapid removal of the dead fish is important for ecosystem health and odor control. General information about fish kills in Florida can be found at the following website: https://edis.ifas.ufl.edu/publication/FA104.pdf
- 3. <u>Floating debris:</u> The CDD contracts with an aquatics vendor who is on the DWB property every Tuesday. They treat any issues in each pond at least once per month and sometimes several times per month. We are trying to minimize grass and other debris that can increase the organic load to the ponds. Grass clippings from mowing may enter the pond between the aquatic vendor visits. If any grass clippings are seen in the ponds, the CDD would like you to contact the CDD District Manager and report your findings.
- 4. <u>Erosion of pond banks:</u> Pond bank erosion can occur anywhere in the approximately 53,000 linear feet of pon banks in Del Webb Bexley. The CDD has contracted with our District Engineer to do a study of all our pond and sump banks. The study will include detailed photographs of the banks together with estimates on any recommended repairs and the timeframe in which the repairs should be made. General information about

stormwater ponds and bank erosion can be found at the following website: https://edis.ifas.ufl.edu/topics/stormwater retention ponds

5. Wetland areas: Wetland areas are important for the proper operation of our storm water management system and for local wildlife. Del Webb Bexley has 11 wetland areas. Some are completely contained in the community and some extend beyond the borders of the community into surrounding areas. Wetland areas are regulated and protected by the Southwest Florida Water Management District from any use or impact by homeowners. General information about wetland areas can be found at the following website: www.swfwmd.state.fl.us/about/newsroom/wetlands.


